WEEKLY REFLECTION

Two Different Worlds

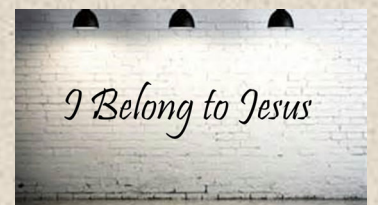
Holiness doesn’t consist of you learning certain patterns of reaction that may be called “virtues.” Holiness consists in you becoming a new creation because Jesus lives in you, because he is the strength that carries you. The Gospel is the good news that Jesus does everything in your life if you remain in him.

The most important thing in life is to be in Jesus and not in oneself. Life in him and life in ourselves are like two completely different worlds. It is easy for each one of us to judge which of these two worlds we live in.

In spite of these two worlds being as different as night and day, there is only a very small distinction between them. You can, at any time, go from your own world to the world of Jesus. All that is needed is a small, inner movement whereby you let go of the hold you have on yourself. It is enough to sincerely and lovingly pronounce his name, saying: “You, Lord, in me and I in you,” or “I belong to you, may your will be done in everything.” Doing this will immediately change your inner landscape.

This ought to be your foremost concern: to remain in him, to live in his world. He doesn’t want you to live in him only every now and then. He wants you in him *always*.

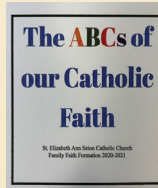
Registration for 2021-2022 Faith Formation will begin late July/early August. We are looking for catechists and assistants.

Fun ways to use your ABCs of our Catholic Faith cards:

- Create a memory matching game. Place all cards face down and take turns turning 2 cards over matching the picture to the clue.
- Separate the photo cards from the clues. Hold up the photo card and see if you can explain the meaning and share as many facts as you know.
- Read the clue card and see if you know the answer without looking at the photo cards.
- Group the cards by categories. For example, people, items found in the church, terms you would like to learn more about, etc.
- Create an anagram- spell a word vertically that tells a story horizontally.
- Mix them all up and put them in alphabetical order.
- Using the Novena card- choose 9 other images and make your own novena.
- Pick one of the virtues from our virtue card and share as many examples as possible of how to demonstrate that virtue.
- Retell stories from the saints we have studied and are listed on the saint card.
- Learn one new fact about each saint on the saint card.

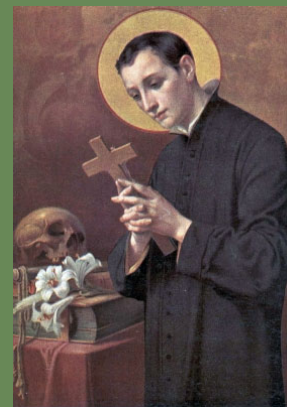

Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque and the Sacred Heart

*"I need nothing but God, and to lose myself in the heart of Jesus."
From a young age, Margaret Alacoque was set apart for the Lord. Devoted to the Blessed Sacrament, she vowed to The Blessed Virgin Mary that she would consecrate herself to the religious life if she was cured of the rheumatic fever that kept her bedridden - and away from her corporal acts of piety - for many years. Margaret's prayers were answered; she took up the name Mary in honor of the Virgin's intercession.*

Margaret Mary was used to receiving visions and private revelations from Our Lord, and thought it was a normal part of life. The one that she became famous for is the revelation of Jesus' Sacred Heart as the image of God's divine love for us, and His desire for us to grow closer to Him through a particular devotion to it. In addition, Margaret Mary was instructed to spend a "Holy Hour" (the first of its kind) on Thursdays contemplating Jesus' agony in the garden of Gethsemane.

Not everyone in Margaret Mary's order believed her visions, but in time the Sacred Heart devotion was approved by the Church and widely embraced by the faithful.

Margaret Mary was beatified in 1864. A few years later, when her tomb was opened, her body was found incorrupt and two miraculous cures immediately took place. She was canonized in 1920; her feast day is October 16th.

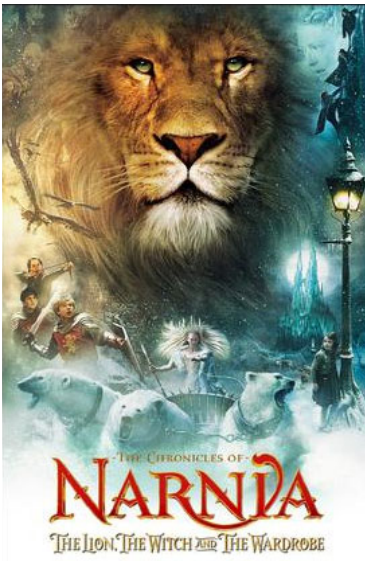


Christine is a local musical theatre voice teacher and professor for Northern Virginia Community College. She studied voice and theatre education at the Catholic University of America.

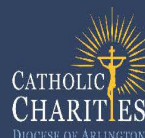

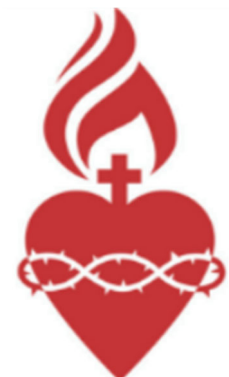
RELIGIOUS FREEDOM WEEK 2021

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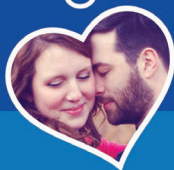
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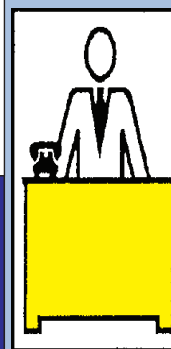
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
