

EIGHT BIBLICAL REASONS FOR WANTING TO SPEND ONE HOUR WITH JESUS IN THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

- 1. **He is really there!** "I myself am the living bread come down from heaven." (In 6:35)
- 2. Day and night Jesus dwells in the Blessed Sacrament because of his Infinite love for you! "Behold I will be with you always even to the end of the world," (Mt 28:20)
- 3. The specific way that Jesus asks you to love him in return is to spend one quiet hour with him in the Blessed Sacrament. "Where your treasure is, there is your heart...." "Could you not watch one hour with me?" (Mt 6:21; 26:40)
- 4. Each moment that you spend in His Eucharistic Presence will increase his divine life within you and deepen your personal relationship and friendship with him. "I have come that you may have life and have it more abundantly." "I am the vine and you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him shall bear much fruit because without me, you can do nothing." (In 15:5)
- 5. **Each hour you spend with Jesus will deepen his divine peace in your heart.** "Come to me all of you who are weary and find life burdensome and I will refresh you..." "Cast all of you anxieties upon the one who cares for you..." "My Peace is My Gift to you." (Mt 11:28; Pt 5:7; Jn 14:17)
- 6. **For peace in our country!** "When my people humble themselves and seek my presence... I will revive their land." (2Chr 7:14)
- 7. **Jesus will bless you, your family and the whole world for this hour of faith you spend with Him in the Blessed Sacrament.** "Blessed are they who do not see and yet believe..." "Faith can move mountains..." "What is needed is trust..." "Behold I come to make all things new." (Jn 20:29; Mk 11:23; Mk 5:36; Rev 21:5)
- 8. Each moment you spend with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament brings joy, pleasure, and delight to his Sacred Heart! "My joy, my pleasure, my delight is to be with you." (Prov 8:31)

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Make Room for God!

God's love can't flow into us if we are full of our own ambitions, worries, and critical judgments. We need to clean out quite a bit within us to make room for God. God doesn't demand that everything shall be in mint condition. He is happy if only there is enough room for him to enter. If you have begun to tidy up within you, you will feel that every time you have thrown something out for the sake of



God, you are filled with his love instead. And then you won't want to stop until the whole house is clean. God is not so easy to find if you are full of noise and confusion. God is a friend of silence and order, and his own life is an ocean of silence filled with love. Your silence is disturbed not only by your talking to someone else, but even more by your talking to yourself, or the attention you show to thoughts and images that float around in your head. You can even disturb this silence by talking too much with God. If you continually want to inform him about your wishes and your thoughts about what he should do, God will have no opportunity to quietly whisper how precious you are to him and that he loves you eternally. Prayer is a dialogue with God. As the very best dialogue partner, God speaks to you in the language of silence. Your part of the conversation consists primarily in listening to his silence. And listening to the silence is only possible if you yourself are quiet and still.






