

FROM OUR PAROCHIAL VICAR



Well this past week, we celebrated the feast day of a very popular saint who happens to be among my very favorites: Saint Francis of Assisi. And while many people are familiar with him, it's also true that many people simply don't really know or understand him.

Even those who are vaguely familiar with Christianity would recognize the figure of the plaster statue in the garden surrounded by various animals and give a nod of recognition: "that's Saint Francis of Assisi." And while it's true that this holy man had a way of relating with the natural world that was unique, it was not this that made him a saint. Saint Francis was passionately devoted to Christ, especially to Our Lord Jesus Christ truly present in the Most Holy Eucharist.

Many people are familiar with the popular prayer that has been put to music entitled "The Prayer of Saint Francis of Assisi. "Lord make me an instrument of your peace... Etc." And while we can certainly imagine him praying in this way, the biographers who studied his life tell us that Saint Francis most likely never said this. These are words that have been attributed to him. But there is a prayer of Saint Francis that he did say very often. If you've been to Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament you've heard the priest pray these words in an additional praise of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament: "May the Heart of Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament be praised, adored, and loved, with grateful affection at every moment, in all the tabernacles of the world even until the end of time.' This is most certainly *the* prayer of Saint Francis.

Saint Francis used to go into the town and in front of the doors of the Church, he would fall down in adoration. If the Church doors were locked, he would belt out this prayer for all to hear! And while I don't necessarily recommend that we adopt this particular devotion, since most likely, if someone were to do this today, it would get them carted off to a padded cell where they would receive immediate medical intervention, I do ask you the question: Our Church doors are unlocked quite often. We unlock the doors at 7:30 AM and close the Church at 9 PM. Will you come to visit the Eucharistic King? Can we love a person we seldom visit? Is it true that in this Parish, the Heart of Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament is praised adored and love with grateful affection?

I don't think Saint Francis would mind if I closed with the words of the great Benedictine Abbott, Blessed Columba Marmion. Let these words be for you a challenge...an invitation: "He awaits us in the Tabernacle, not only to receive our homage there, but to communicate His graces to us there also. If our faith in His Words is not just vain sentiment, we shall go close to Him and put our souls into contact, through faith, with His Sacred Humanity. Be assured that "power will go forth from Him, (Luke 6:19; 8:46,) as of old, to fill us with light, peace, and joy."

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Choose God Now

Jesus places a decisive choice before his disciples. If they want to follow him, they must receive him as he is, with everything he tells them. He also says that no one can come to him unless it is given as a gift from the Father (Jn 6:44). To be so completely dependent is not agreeable to anyone who wants to build his or her own little life. But it is glorious —yes, the greatest glory—to let go of your own and freely enter this unconditional surrender to the Father.

No one is forced to receive his invitation. But Jesus knows that human happiness lies in surrendering completely to the Father and the Father's love. That is why he turns to each one of us and appeals to our love and faithfulness: "Do you also wish to go away?" And each and every one of us ought to answer as did Peter: "Lord, to whom can we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and know that you are the Holy One of God" (Jn 6:67-69).

Peter would turn out to be weak afterward, exactly as you will be weak. But that doesn't matter *now*. His subsequent weakness doesn't diminish his honesty in the moment of assuring the Lord of his faithfulness. And Jesus doesn't question the sincerity of Peter's words.

Do you dare to devote yourself to Jesus even if you are afraid of not being able to see it through? Say your "yes" to Jesus *now*, and he himself will take care of your future.
