FROM OUR DEACON



Today's Gospel focuses on St. Joseph, the step-father of Jesus. We so often talk about Mary as a godly woman – an example of virtue, faith and obedience, but tend to neglect Joseph. Perhaps that is because as important as Joseph was in Christ's life, not a single word that he ever spoke is recorded anywhere in the Bible. He listens and obeys; that's all that's recorded. We assume his words are recorded because we can visualize the conversations he must had with Mary and the Angel Gabriel, yet they are not recorded in the scriptures. We imagine a dialog between him and the innkeeper, but that's pure speculation since all the Bible says about it is "there was no room for them at the inn." We can visualize Joseph teaching Jesus about carpentry, but nothing about that is actually recorded about it in the New Testament.



Yet if you look at Joseph's life in the Gospels, you see that he was every bit as godly and exemplary as Mary. He was confronted with a very challenging and upsetting situation – the woman who was betrothed to him is with child, and he knows it's not his child. Think of what a betrayal it must have seemed to Joseph! He could have publicly accused Mary of immorality, because that's how it appeared. He would certainly have been within his rights under Jewish law to do so. But Matthew says because he was "...not willing to make her a public example, he was minded to put her away privately." Joseph had made his decision; he would be kind and sensitive towards Mary, but divorce her in secret. At that point, God sends an angel to him in a dream to help him overturn his original decision.



God intervenes and asks more of Joseph and he accepts God's will. Joseph had an essential role in the Incarnation, just like Mary. He received the message of an angel, just like her, and Our Lord could not have been born if he had not said 'yes.' His 'yes' to God's call was essential, just like Our Lady's. St. Joseph is a model of faith and obedience. We too are called to look beyond our own understanding and knowledge and accept things in faith like Joseph did.

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Two Primary Advent Figures

During Advent you may be looking forward to all the beautiful experiences of Christmas. But advent is not meant as a waiting period for this. Rather, you are awaiting someone who will come closer to you than you are to yourself.

Advent is like a portal you have to walk through to enter the sanctuary of Christmas. The portal is flanked by two figures who guard the sanctuary and ask you why you want to enter, and at the same time teach you how to do it.

Both figures are very dissimilar. One is big and strong, a man clothed in camels' hair. But in spite of his size, this man wants only to be a voice calling out in the desert: "Prepare the way of the Lord."

The other is a vulnerable woman expecting a child. She doesn't cry out, she is silent, total attention to what is happening within her. The only she quietly whispers is: "I am the servant of the Lord."

They both know who they are waiting for. They are not awaiting better times, or nicer experiences. They are waiting for God, and they know that nothing can hinder his arrival if they are open to receive him.

If you also know who you are waiting for, if you are sure about his arrival, then you are celebrating Advent in the proper way.

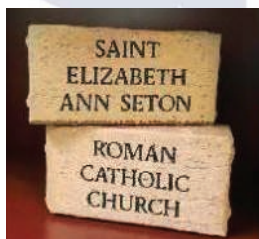

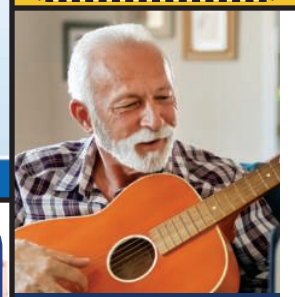
