



#### FROM OUR DEACON



In today's Gospel (Matthew 5:17-37), Jesus tells us that He did not come to abolish the law, but "to fulfill" the law given to them through Moses. The implication here is that Jesus is a more authoritative person than Moses. The influential leaders of the time met these words with great hostility. In their mind, Jesus was no one to preach about a kingdom which demanded a higher standard of human conduct than that called for by Moses. Jesus demanding a higher standard contradicts the image of the loving God that holds us to no standards and whose forgiveness is free and unconditional.

It is true that God's love for us is free and unconditional. It is also true that His mercy is limitless and that He very much wants to extend that mercy to all of us. But the words He taught us are clear that this mercy depends on what we do. Think of the words of the *Our Father*, given to us by Jesus-"forgive us our trespasses <u>AS</u> we forgive those who have trespassed against us" or the Beatitude He spoke on the mount — "Blessed are the merciful; they shall receive mercy." In short, if you are to receive forgiveness, then you must first forgive others. Likewise, if you want mercy, you must show mercy. Below are three excerpts from the Gospel which should really wake us up:

- \* "whoever is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment;"
- \* "whoever says, 'You fool,' will be liable to fiery Gehenna"
- \* "If your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one of your members than to have your whole body thrown into Gehenna."

These are not my words but those of Jesus Himself and although they are not easy to hear, we should not ignore them. Jesus tells us that it's not only what we do and don't do, but what is in our hearts. That's where real conversion must take place. Observing external laws is not enough. Jesus wants listening hearts, courageous, generous and discerning hearts like His. He gives us these words so that we can live by them. He knows we are not perfect. His apostles were not perfect, yet He chose them anyway. But because He wants all of us to be with Him forever, He spoke these words to show us the way to Him.

Do you take Jesus' words seriously? Do you strive to live as He calls us to live? Every day, every moment, you have a choice! What will you choose today?

Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give

us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from

For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever and ever.

Amen.

## **WEEKLY REFLECTION**

#### The Father Himself Loves You

It would be a good exercise to try to summarize the good news of Christ into a single phrase. That which you really understand, you can usually say in a few words. Needing a lot of words to explain something is often a sign that we haven't really grasped the core of what we are trying to express.

So, if we were to express the Gospel in a few words, some would probably say that it is primarily about conversion, others that the most important message is to love on another. Many possibilities exist. If I were to sum up the Gospel, I would suggest these words of Jesus: "The Father himself loves you" (Jn 16:27)

If you know that the Father loves you, if you know it with your whole being, then your heart has found its home. Then the Gospel is not about you having to do this or that. Then it is only a matter of trusting and receiving his love.

Knowing you are loved will eradicate any real worries within you. "Therefore do not worry," Jesus says, "your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things." (Mt. 6:31-32).

Anxieties are a sign of a lack of trust. It is important to realize the distinction between anxiety and the well-placed concern you must have for your own affairs and those of others.

Worry, in the form of anxious restlessness, makes no sense if you know that your Father takes care of you and provides for all your needs. Knowing that he loves you more than you could ever love yourself can fill your life with an unshakable peace.





# LITURGICAL LIVING



Ember Days are days of fasting, abstinence and prayer with a three-fold purpose:

- To thank God for the gifts of nature
- Teach men to make use of them in moderation
- \* Assist the needy

The Church celebrates Ember Days four times each year, tied to the changing of the seasons, but also, to the liturgical cycles of the Church. The significance of the days of the week is: **Wednesday** was the day Christ was betrayed; **Friday** was the day He was crucified; and **Saturday** was the day He was entombed.

## Why do we celebrate Ember Days?

Our parish celebrates Ember Days as part of \*Living Liturgically in our parish. Liturgical Living is a framework through which we faithful can discover and develop a more personal, intentional, and meaningful relationship with Christ, the Church, and our Catholic Faith.

#### \*Lit. Living's Purpose is twofold

- To help Catholics understand and live out their baptismal promises by immersing themselves in the cycle of seasons etc. that make up the liturgical year.
- 2) To instill a sense of confidence in every layperson, regardless of their capacity within the parish community, to share their faith and inspire others to encounter Christ.




