FROM OUR DEACON



In today's Gospel, Jesus provides three examples of things of value. In the first example, He speaks of a "treasure buried in a field." The second example references a "pearl of great price" and the third speaks of "fish of every kind" but distinguishes between good and bad fish. The common theme of these three examples is about prioritizing things of value and discarding that which is of little or no value.

For all of us at Mass today, we know the greatest treasure we could ever possibly conceive of is Heaven. It is to Heaven that we all aspire and to which we (hopefully) have directed our lives to entering. Heaven is not just mythical or imaginary place, but our true home where we will live with God forever. We know this because Jesus told us so. It is for this treasure that Jesus gave all that He had to purchase for us. The unbeliever would understandably question how we could possibly know Heaven except in our imagination. That's a fair question. I, like you, can only imagine what Heaven will be like. In fact, Jesus told us that it will be far better than anything we can imagine, but because we can only imagine it at this point, we are often understandably preoccupied with the things of this world. In this life, we don't have to use our imagination because we have physical senses to see, hear, feel, touch, and taste. For this reason, the things of our earthly lives seem more real to us and often command all of our focus and attention.

Jesus tells us, however, that things we focus on in this life are as nothing compared to the great treasure that is Heaven. This great gift is ours for the taking. We do not have to earn it. Jesus has already paid the price for our entrance because He knew we could not purchase it on our own. He gave all He had for us because He views us as a great treasure, a pearl of great price. Although we cannot repay the debt He already paid, He does expect us to put Him first and has been very clear about that. God commands that we live as He taught and expects us to prioritize Him above all else.

To put God first, we must identify and discard like bad fish those things or habits or even thoughts that get in the way of our prioritizing Him above all else. When we fail to do this, we simply need to ask for His forgiveness and if our request is sincere and our intentions pure, we will receive it.

Jesus came to save us, not condemn us. He wants very much for us to be with Him in Heaven, but if we choose to treat the things of this world as pearls of great price instead of Him, we condemn ourselves — we become like those fish that are not placed in buckets, but are thrown away. So, the questions we must ask ourselves are — what do we treat as treasures? What is it that we direct our time, our attention, our emotion and our resources? Is it for the passing things of this world or those that will lead us to our true home in Heaven?

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Harmony With God

John writes in his first letter: "And this is the boldness we have in him, that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us" (5:14). Rather than coming from a sincere wish to do God's will, prayer often has its roots in egoism. Not until you thank God with all your heart do you step out of yourself and become united with God's will. From the perspective of his will you can then see more clearly what you are to ask. Then you will be certain that your prayer will be answered. "We received from him whatever we ask, because we obey his commandments and do what pleases him" (1 Jn 3:22).

If you constantly praise and give thanks to God in all that happens, then you live in harmony with him, which means that you won't be asking for anything that doesn't harmonize with God's will. God will then recognize in you his own Spirit, who "intercedes for the saints according to the will of God" (Rom 8:27).

The earliest Christians didn't live in circumstances more conducive than ours. They suffered severe persecutions. To profess Christ carried a constant risk of losing one's life. Yet Paul wrote to them: "sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs among yourselves, singing and making melody to the Lord in your hearts, giving thanks to God the Father at all times and for everything in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ" (Eph 5:19-20).

When you turn your gaze on God you will gain insight into what is best for you and for all.





St. Ignatius of Loyola

“Because there were no books of romance on hand during his convalescence, Ignatius whiled away the time reading a life of Christ and lives of the saints. His conscience was deeply touched, and a long, painful turning to Christ began. Having seen the Mother of God in a vision, he made a pilgrimage to her shrine at Montserrat near Barcelona.

He remained for almost a year at nearby Manresa, sometimes with the Dominicans, sometimes in a pauper's hospice, often in a cave in the hills praying. After a period of great peace of mind, he went through a harrowing trial of scruples. There

was no comfort in anything—prayer, fasting, sacraments, penance.

At length, his peace of mind returned. It was during this year of conversion that Ignatius began to write down material that later became his greatest work, the *Spiritual Exercises*.

Ignatius was a true mystic. He centered his spiritual life on the essential foundations of Christianity—the Trinity, Christ, the Eucharist. His spirituality is expressed in the Jesuit motto, *Ad majorem Dei gloriam*—“for the greater glory of God.” In his concept, obedience was to be the prominent virtue, to assure the effectiveness and mobility of his men. All activity was to be guided by a true love of the Church and unconditional obedience to the Holy Father, for which reason all professed members

took a fourth vow to go wherever the pope should send them for the salvation of souls.”
