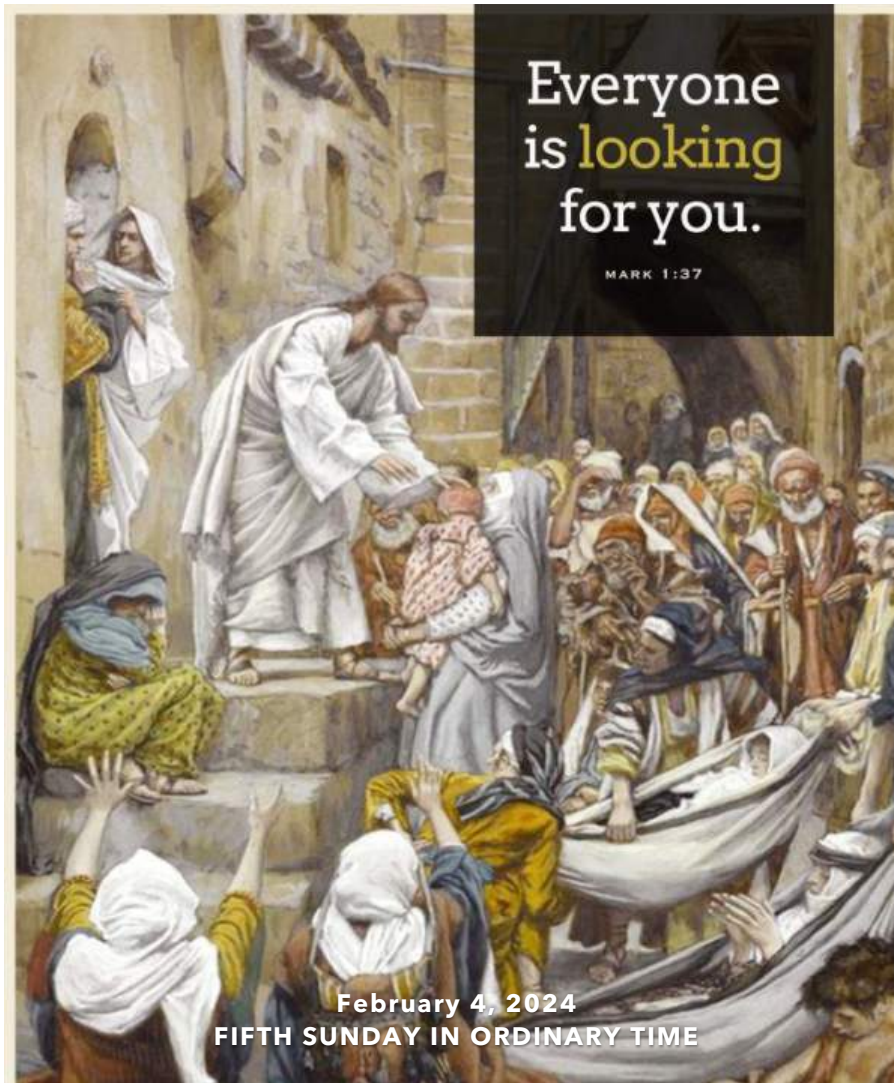

BISHOP BURBIDGE'S RESPONSE TO PRESIDENT BIDEN'S PRO-ABORTION RALLY IN VIRGINIA

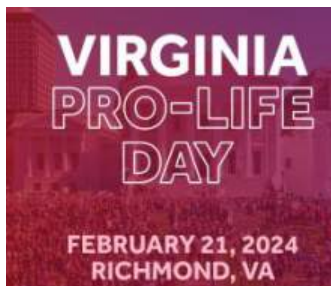


President Biden has made abortion the centerpiece of his campaign. At a rally in Manassas, VA, he advocated for codifying *Roe v. Wade* into law. It is incredibly devastating to know President Biden would place “choice” over his sacred duty to protect life.

President Biden's rally took place just four miles from the Manassas Mother of Mercy Free Medical Clinic, where Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Arlington offers free prenatal care to pregnant women in need and their unborn children. In the year after the *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health* decision, **the Diocese of Arlington delivered \$877,000 in free medical care** to more than 1,000 women. Going further, the diocese also provided rent and utilities assistance, nearly 400,000 diapers, and 4,000 cans of formula to families in need.

Despite what this administration claims, taking the life of an innocent child is never a “choice.” Women who are facing unexpected or difficult pregnancies deserve assistance that affirms and supports life - not destroy it. Abortion remains the preeminent civil rights issue of our time, yet, just yesterday, the Biden administration announced renewed efforts to increase access to medically unsafe prescription abortion pills. This is clearly not about women's health.

The Diocese of Arlington and the entire pro-life movement will remain steadfast in ensuring parents facing unexpected or challenging pregnancies have the support they need to choose life for their unborn children.

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Love Is Not an Ideology

Many people, believers and nonbelievers alike, are aware that love is the only transforming power in the world. But they believe in love the way they believe in democracy.

The love we Christians profess is not an ideology. Saint John writes in his first letter: “We have known and believe the love that God has for us” (4:16). This love is a personal relationship. We don't believe the world is changed by ethical principles, however noble these may be. The Apostles' Creed consists of twelve fundamental pronouncements about God's love for humankind. All of the Scriptures, all of Christian theology, is nothing but an explanation of this love.

Through faith, you know you are loved by God with a creative, respectful, unique, and personal love. God calls you by name. God knows your joys and disappointments, your weaknesses and strengths, hopes and feelings. “You search out my path and my lying down, and are acquainted with all my ways.... You hem me in, behind and before, and lay your hand upon me” (Ps 139:3, 5).

The hardest thing for a human being is to comprehend that he or she is loved by such a love. Your whole life, every hour of prayer, all your spiritual reading, ought to deal with making this truth come alive in you. If you know yourself to be loved, you will radiate this love to the world.

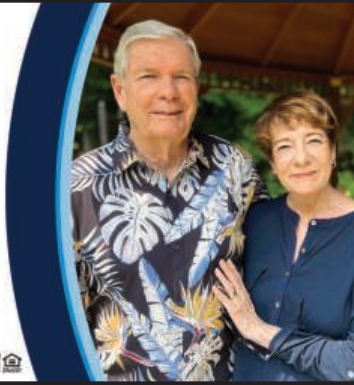
