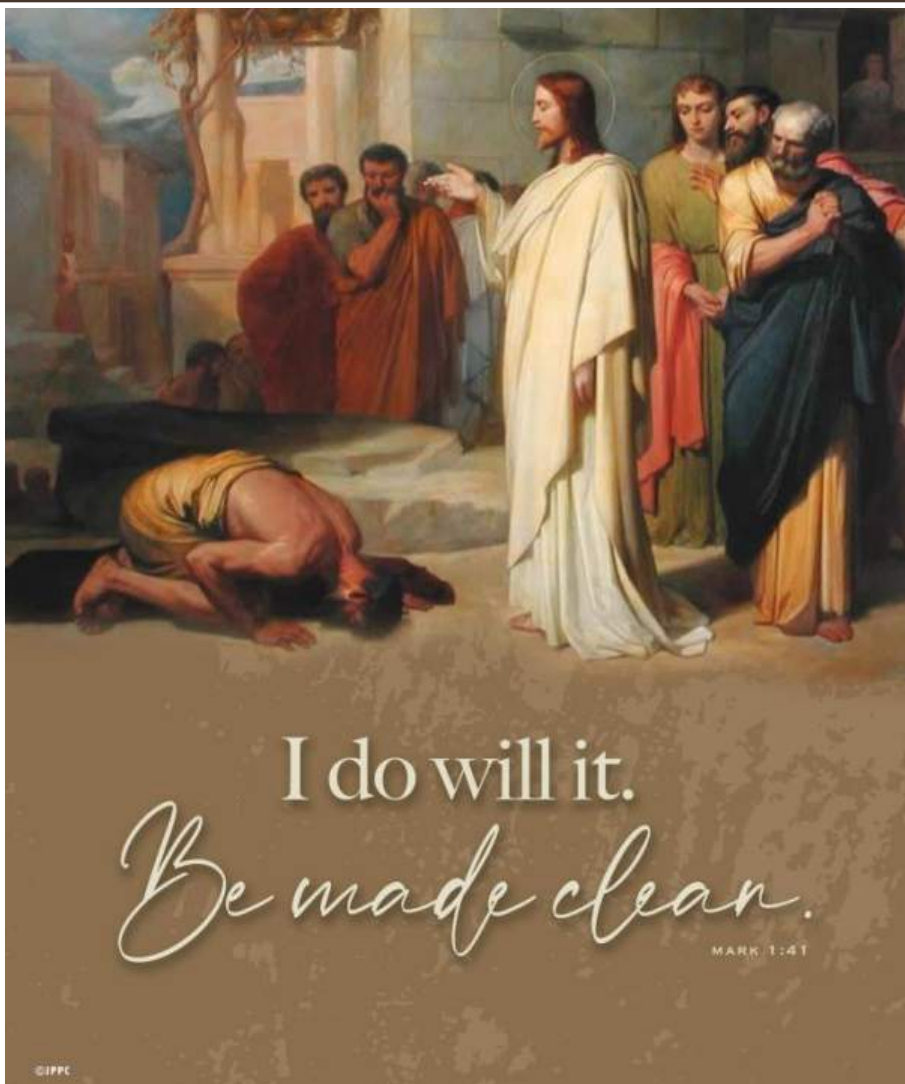

FROM OUR DEACON



During a recent discussion on St. Joseph I recently had with others at a session of That Man Is You (TMIY), it occurred to me that I couldn't recall a time when I prayed to ask for his intercession. Like so many, when I have a spiritual need, I usually petition God directly. In recent years, I've also made a habit of going to the Blessed Mother to ask for her intercession, but I have never really given as much time, thought, or attention to St. Joseph as he deserves.

I've always taken St. Joseph for granted. Maybe it's because not a single word of his is recorded anywhere in the Bible. Joseph's actions, however, spoke louder than his words ever could. He exemplified strength, humility, love, and fatherhood. If we're going to look to anyone for a model of what it means to be a man and a father, St. Joseph is hard to beat. He was faithful to God, kept his promises to Mary, and diligently protected Jesus. He was a man of his word and always followed through for the people he loved. Because of his special role as foster-father of Jesus, St. Joseph has merited singular privileges in heaven unmatched by any saint except the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Here are 3 ways you can pray to St. Joseph for his intercession:

Help with Work. We know St. Joseph to be a carpenter and one of his patronages is labor and of working people. Ask him to help inspire a Christian attitude toward work. It is easy to complain at the sight of work or to not use our talents in the way God calls us to. Ask for help in developing the spiritual qualities which St. Joseph exemplified than to strive for material success.

For Graces in Fatherhood. We know St. Joseph to be the husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the earthly father of Jesus. He led and protected his family, the family of Nazareth during very challenging circumstances. St. Joseph was able to do this by the strength of God and by his faith. The fathers in our own lives also face trying situations whether they be day to day or special hardships. Ask for St. Joseph's intercession to assist fathers and obtain the graces they need.

For the Impossible Situations. St. Joseph is known to be a man of great faith. He took the "impossible situation" of his spouse, the Blessed Virgin Mary, conceiving a child by the Holy Spirit and said yes to God's call to accept her and lead their family. St. Joseph said yes to the plan of God which I'm sure came with fear and uncertainty. Ask for his intercession for the confidence that God can take any impossible situation and bring goodness from it.

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Love the Depth in the Other

There is an abyss the way humans think and the way God thinks. God never considers his rights. He even abdicates his right to be God to become one of us (Phil 2:6-7). God never repays evil with evil, he conquers evil with good. And when evil becomes greater, he gives even more love. "Where sin increased, grace abounded all the more" (Rom 5:20).

Love of enemies is a self-evident Christian posture/ God has shown each and every one of us an overabundance of love, and this love we must share. We know Jesus died for all and that his sacrificial death gives every human person a godlike value. For this reason, there is really no sense in speaking of enemies – a Christian has no enemies. We know we are all children of the same Father, that we all belong to God. How, then, can we loathe anyone who is surrounded and protected by God's love as much as we are?

We cannot deny the presence of evil in human beings. But, deep down, the other is always a brother or a sister, and it is this depth we must love.

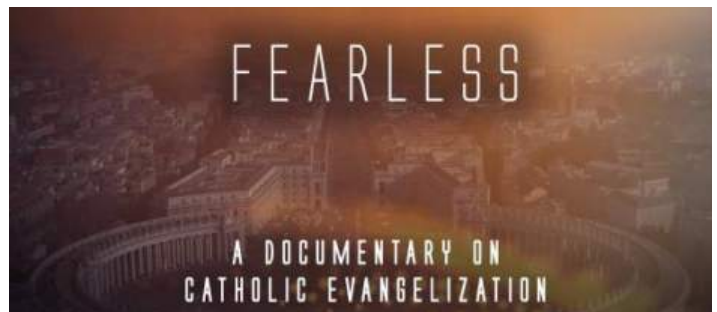

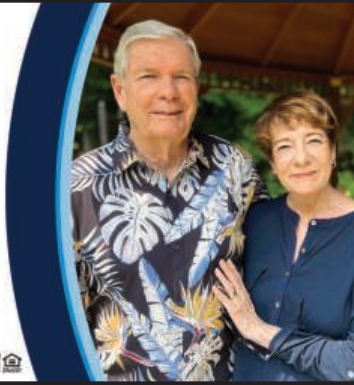
