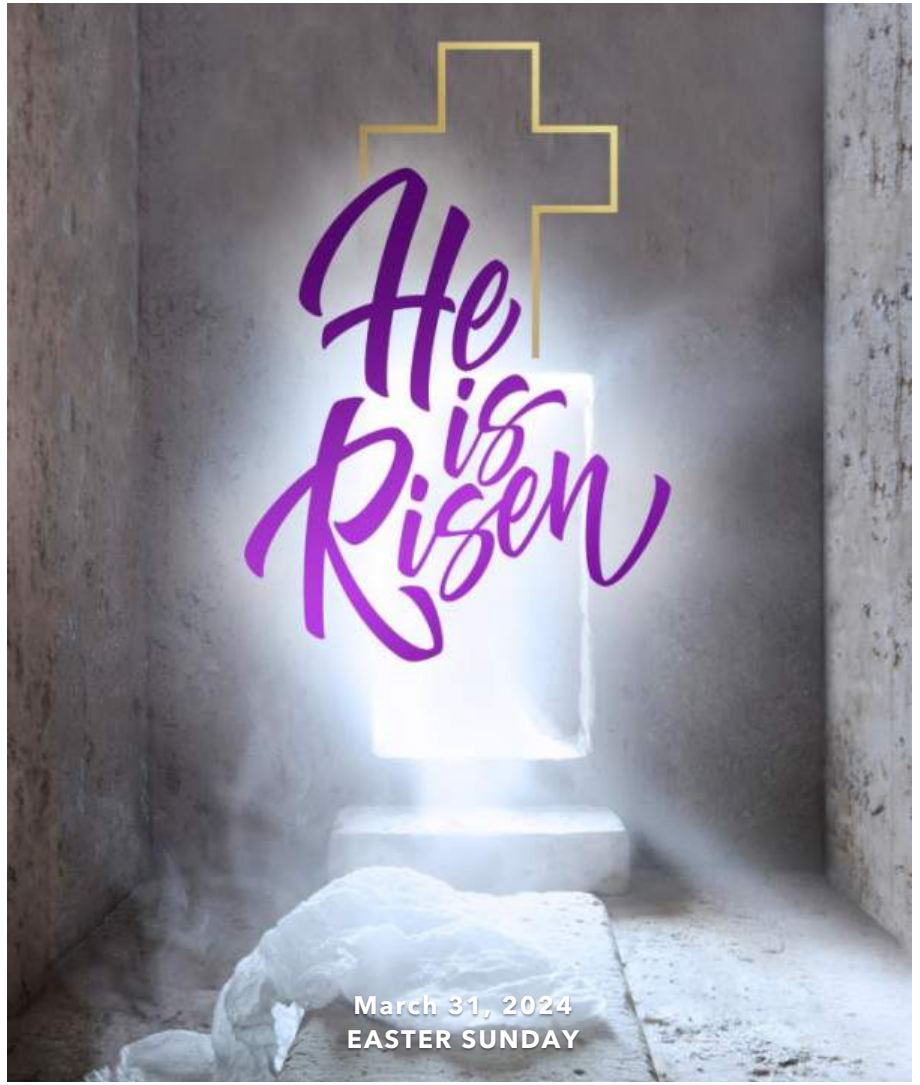

Fifty Days of Rejoicing



After Lent's forty days of preparation for Easter, it would be anticlimactic to celebrate the feast of Easter for only one day. Jesus is risen! He is alive! Holy Mother Church in her wisdom ensures that we celebrate the resurrection longer than we do the season of penance. The Paschal Mystery, Christ's passion, death and resurrection, is central to our faith. Jesus conquered sin and death and reopened the gates of heaven, which were closed due to the original sin of Adam and Eve. Through His victory over death and our rebirth in baptism we share in everlasting life

While the Resurrection is the nucleus and celebrated in our Faith every day, we particularly "exult and rejoice" during the Octave of Easter and Easter season "The fifty days from Easter Sunday to Pentecost are celebrated as one feast day, sometimes called 'the great Sunday'" (Catholicculture.org)
