## WEEKLY REFLECTION

### Live a Risen Life

"I was dead, and see, I am alive forever and ever," Christ says triumphantly (Rev 1:18). This revolutionizes our lives. When Jesus rises, he doesn't do so alone. He takes with him all who believe in him.

To believe in the Lord's resurrection is to believe in one's own resurrection. Not only a resurrection sometime in the future, on the last day, but a resurrection that has already taken place.

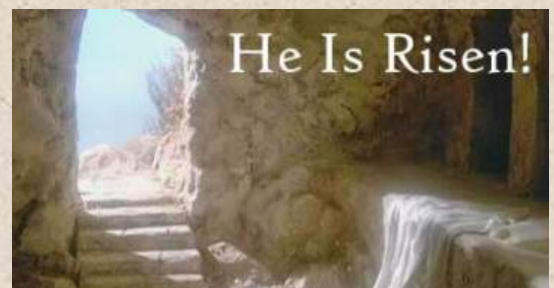
Through faith and baptism you have died to sin. You have received a new life, and this life is Christ. Are you giving this life what it needs to act itself out?

Humans often turn things upside down, which makes life very complicated. We strive for the true life as an elevated ideal which we may eventually reach if we work hard enough at it. We develop a certain moral code and then try – by our own efforts and strengths – to acquire virtues, be good, and irreproachable.

The New testament, especially Saint Paul, takes a different view of this. Holiness is something we have already been given – we carry it deep within us. All we need to do is let this holiness shine through us. Because we are God's chosen and holy ones we should be good, friendly, and humble (see Col 3:12).

Once you are truly convinced of the holiness inside of you, you will no longer sin. There will be harmony between what you most intimately are and what you do. If you clothe yourself in your true being, Christ, then everything you do will be influenced by him. Then you are living, even now, a risen life.

## THE TRUTH IS SOMETHING WE RECEIVE, NOT SOMETHING WE MAKE.

Faithful Citizenship (Seton Lake Ridge VCC Advocacy Team)

Participation in political life requires judgments about concrete circumstances. While the bishops help form the laity in accordance with basic principles, they do not tell the laity to vote for particular candidates. On these often complex matters, it is the laity's responsibility to form their consciences and grow in the virtue of prudence to approach the many and varied issues of the day with the mind of Christ.

Conscience is "a judgment of reason" by which one determines whether an action is right or wrong (see Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 1778). It does not allow us to justify doing whatever we want, nor is it a mere "feeling." Conscience – properly formed according to God's revelation and the teaching of the Church – is a means by which one listens to God and discerns how to act in accordance with the truth.

*The truth is something we receive, not something we make. We can only judge using the conscience we have, but our judgments do not make things true.*

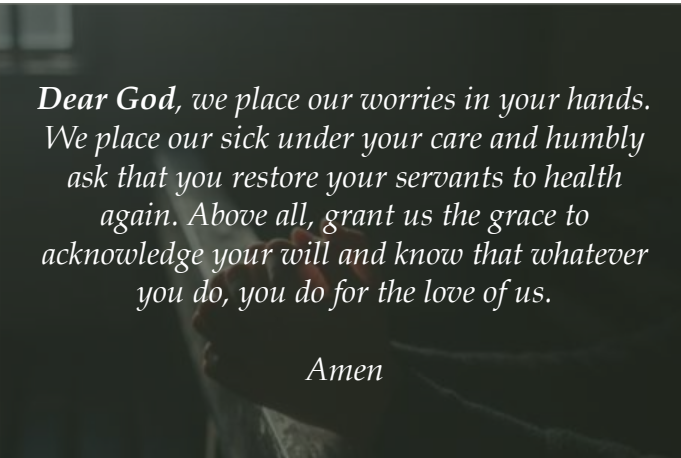
