

FROM OUR PAROCHIAL VICAR



Pentecost might have been 2 months ago, but the Holy Spirit is active in our lives everyday — or at least he wants to be, if we allow him! St. Basil the Great (c. 330—c. 379 A.D.), bishop of Caesarea in central Asia Minor, wrote a beautiful treatise on the Holy Spirit that has inspired the Church ever since. Here is a little piece of it as found in the <u>Liturgy of the Hours</u> on the Tuesday of the Seventh Week of Easter. Enjoy!

"The titles given to the Holy Spirit must surely stir the soul of anyone who hears them, and make him realize that they speak of nothing less than the supreme Being. Is he not called the Spirit of God, the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, the steadfast Spirit, the guiding Spirit? But his principal and most per-

the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, the steadfast Spirit, the guiding Spirit? But his principal and most personal title is the Holy Spirit.

"To the Spirit all creatures turn in their need for sanctification; all living things seek him according to their ability. His breath empowers each to achieve its own natural end.

"The Spirit is the source of holiness, a spiritual light, and he offers his own light to every mind to help it in its search for truth. By nature, the Spirit is beyond the reach of our mind, but we can know him by his goodness. The power of the Spirit fills the whole universe, but he gives himself only to those who are worthy, acting in each according to the measure of his faith.

"Simple in himself, the Spirit is manifold in his mighty works. The whole of his being is present to each individual; the whole of his being is present everywhere. Though shared in by many, he remains unchanged; his self-giving is no loss to himself. Like the sunshine, which permeates all the atmosphere, spreading over land and sea, and yet is enjoyed by each person as though it were for him alone, so the Spirit pours forth his grace in full measure, sufficient for all, and yet is present as though exclusively to everyone who can receive him. To all creatures that share in him, he gives a delight limited only by their own nature, not by his ability to give.

"The Spirit raises our hearts to heaven, guides the steps of the weak, and brings to perfection those who are making progress. He enlightens those who have been cleansed from every stain of sin and makes them spiritual by communion with himself.

"As clear, transparent substances become very bright when sunlight falls on them and shine with a new radiance, so also souls in whom the Spirit dwells, and who are enlightened by the Spirit, become spiritual themselves and a source of grace for others.

From the Spirit comes foreknowledge of the future, understanding of the mysteries of faith, insight into the hidden meaning of Scripture, and other special gifts. Through the Spirit, we become citizens of heaven, we are admitted to the company of the angels, we enter into eternal happiness and abide in God. Through the Spirit, we acquire a likeness to God; indeed, we attain what is beyond our most sublime aspirations—we become God."

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Prayer Matures Us

There are two ways to pray. One is to ask something from God: you pray, you insist, you get stubborn and "fight" with God to have your wishes come true.

The parable about the widow and the judge (Lk 18:1-7) shows this form of prayer. The widow asks the judge that justice is given her. At first, the judge refuses, but since the widow is so persistent, he finally gives in. Jesus adds: "And will not God grant justice to his chosen ones who cry to him day and night? Will he delay long in helping them? I tell you, he will quickly grant justice to them."

The point of this parable is not that we are to be so tenacious that God finally gives us what we want as if we had "worn him out." God is not like the judge. God gives us our right as soon as we ask. God answers every prayer. God always fulfills the needs of the one who prays.

But the day may come when we realize that our wishes have little to do with our real needs — that we need to change our wishes. Our prayer grows and matures; its point of gravity gradually moves away from our own selves toward God.

Prayer becomes a way of being, of being silent with God, gazing at him in wonderment, listening, and being open to receive. Prayer becomes letting yourself be loved.

Both work-force development programs are focused on increasing moms' prospects of long-term financial independence and sustained housing success.
