FROM OUR PASTOR



The Gospels clearly describe how Jesus showed special love and compassion for the sick and dying throughout his public ministry. So too, the Church today reaches out to those who are suffering and to their families. In this spirit, the **Catholic Bishops of Virginia** have issued this document to help individuals and families navigate the tough decisions that must be made when confronted with any serious illness.

The CATHOLIC ADVANCE MEDICAL DIRECTIVE is a legal instrument authorized by, and meeting the requirements of the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, which can be completed for use by all Catholics – whether young or old, healthy or dying. "The CAMDs" and accompanying Q&A pamphlet are available in our parish office. Simply stop by to pick one up for each family member you wish to cover.

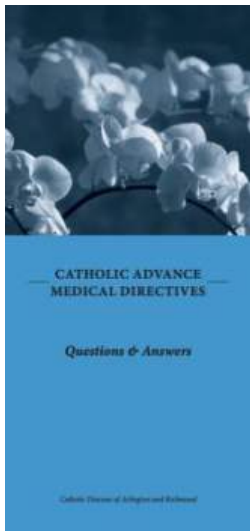
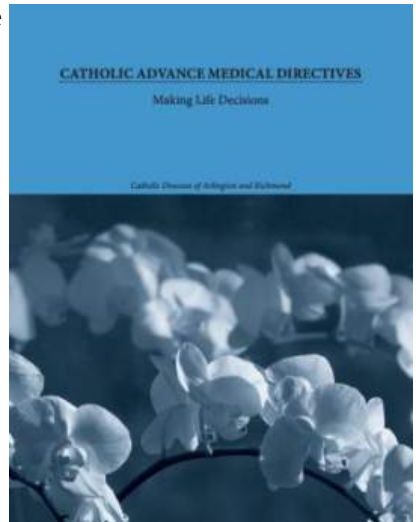
While the Church cannot give a ready-made answer for each situation, it does provide guidance and direction. By drawing on Sacred Scripture, the Traditions handed down to us from the Apostles and the Doctrines of the Catholic Church,

the Bishops are able to address many of the concerns that challenge us in this age of technology and modern medical science.

In making decisions about what constitutes appropriate medical treatment, **we must always be alert to the differences between what the State permits and what the Church teaches.** We also should not hesitate to discuss our concerns with our medical providers and pastoral counselor or priest. Please be aware that federal privacy law forbids health care facilities from notifying clergy that you or your loved one has been hospitalized; therefore, it will be necessary for you to call for a Catholic priest hospital chaplain, or contact us to request a visit from a priest.

Remember that we are never alone when facing illness. The Church accompanies us through its various ministries and with the Sacraments, which bring the loving and redeeming embrace of Jesus. This includes not only the Sacraments of Reconciliation and the Eucharist, but also the **Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick**. Sacramental Anointing provides special graces to those seriously ill or dying as the Bible teaches, *"Is anyone among you sick? Then summon the presbyters (priests) of the church, and they should pray over you and anoint you with oil in the name of the Lord."* (James 5:14; CCC nos. 1499-1525).

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Rooted in the Peace of Christ

Some insist that true Christian peace includes total control over one's emotional life and an elimination of the passions. But this is based on a misunderstanding of the nature of the human passions. In and of themselves, passions are neither good nor bad. It is our will that determines whether they become constructive or destructive forces.

Jesus' unshakable peace was rooted in his always being one with the will of his Father. His human feelings and passions served this will. Jesus knew joy, sadness, and fear; he was surprised, he became upset and angry.

It would be unreasonable for you to strive for a peace that resembles an unmoving, glassy surface of a lake. If you wish to be like Jesus, you are not to suppress every emotional stirring. But you should let your feelings be rooted in an infinitely deep peace of trust in God. Feelings aren't meant to be thrown about heedlessly – they need to be rooted. Only in this way can they fulfill their proper function. Let the peace of Christ reign in your heart (Col 3:15), then you can allow the feelings to express themselves.

What is the St. Margaret of Cortona Transitional and Maternity Housing Program? This Catholic Charities program serves single mothers with wrap-around support to help them re-establish stability and independence. St. Margaret of Cortona Transitional and Maternity Housing offers two program tracks helping single mothers in exceptionally difficult circumstances: 1) Assistance to mothers with children who may be transitioning from homeless and domestic violence shelters to independent living. 2) Assistance to women pregnant with their first child or pregnant moms who already have other children and find themselves at significant risk in their current living situations. Both work-force development programs are focused on increasing moms' prospects of long-term financial independence and sustained housing success. Staff and volunteers offer a wealth of life skills and financial literacy classes, employment training, and intensive case management to residents.

40 HOURS DEVOTION

Thursday – Saturday, August 22-24 | Main Church

The **Forty Hours Devotion** is a special forty-hour period of continuous prayer made before the Blessed Sacrament in solemn exposition. At the heart of the Forty Hours of Devotion is the Holy Eucharist, the very Real and True Presence of God Himself. Scan the QR code to dedicate an hour to sit with our Lord.

The number *forty* has always signified a sacred period of time: the rains during the time of Noah lasted 40 days and nights; the Jews wandered through the desert for 40 years, our Lord fasted and prayed for 40 days before beginning His public ministry. The 40 Hours Devotion remembers that traditional "forty-hour period" from our Lord's burial until the resurrection. The Forty Hours Devotion **begins with a Solemn Mass of Exposition**, which concludes with the **exposition of the Blessed Sacrament** and a **procession**. The Blessed Sacrament remains on the altar in a monstrance. During the next 40 hours, the faithful gather for personal or public prayer in adoration of our Lord.
