## FROM OUR DEACON



Today is the seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary time on the liturgical calendar. It is late July. It is hot. And many of you may feel a little tired at this point in the year. The heat of summer has a way of doing that. A little rest may be in order.

In today's Gospel, Jesus multiplies the loaves and fish to feed thousands. When He realizes they are going to carry Him off to make Him king, He "withdrew again to the mountain alone." He needed some alone time to pray and get some rest. We do not perform miracles as Jesus did, but we also need to make time to pray, play, and get some rest. You and

I are accustomed to a different kind of action in our lives, a different kind of busy-ness—work, taking care of the family, doing things around the house, etc. Even though these activities do not seem nearly as important as performing miracles to feed the multitudes, they are important to God. But as the things on our "to do" lists add up, we can get worn down. God wants us to be physically, mentally and spiritually healthy and ready to do His work. Sometimes, rest is an important part of that. Without it, we become unhealthy and ineffective in whatever we do.

So, as we drift along in the summer, endure the heat, and make life plans, let us also take some time to do what the crowd often did not allow Jesus and His disciples to do — get some rest. Take a take a breath. Do something you enjoy. Many of us are conditioned as Americans to believe that resting means "loafing." And while some have become experts in this, it's also important to take some time out to rest, spend time with family or friends, appreciate the blessings God has given us, and of course pray. Pray always and pray all ways. Any activity, whether it be work, recreation, or rest, can be a form of prayer if it better prepares us to serve God.




## WEEKLY REFLECTION

### Who Do You Say That I Am?

It is a timeless question Jesus once asked the disciples when they were praying alone in a deserted place (Lk 8:18-20). He puts this question to every human being: "Who do you say that I am?"

It is not easy to look into the personality of Jesus. For this reason, it is good that he put the question to the disciples and that he himself approved of the answer. You can't say just anything about Jesus. The answer Peter gives is clear and unmistakable: "You are the Messiah of God."



The question is absolutely decisive. The answer you give will mark the rest of your life. Jesus has spoken very unequivocally about who he is. He has said he is the light and the life of the world without whom we can do nothing, and only the one who eats his body and drinks his blood has life.

No human being, no matter what extraordinary attributes, can make such statements. Only God can do that.

We either accept everything Jesus says, in which case our answer becomes: "You are my life, my peace, my Savior, my Lord and God," or we choose arbitrarily among his words and sayings, in which case you can't meet and get to know him as he really is. You can't get to know God based on what you think. God must be able to say who he is.

### 40 HOURS DEVOTION

Thursday – Saturday, August 22-24 | Main Church

The **Forty Hours Devotion** is a special forty-hour period of continuous prayer made before the Blessed Sacrament in solemn exposition. At the heart of the Forty Hours of Devotion is the Holy Eucharist, the very Real and True Presence of God Himself. Scan the QR code to dedicate an hour to sit with our Lord.

The number *forty* has always signified a sacred period of time: the rains during the time of Noah lasted 40 days and nights; the Jews wandered through the desert for 40 years, our Lord fasted and prayed for 40 days before beginning His public ministry. The 40 Hours Devotion remembers that traditional “forty-hour period” from our Lord’s burial until the resurrection. The Forty Hours Devotion **begins with a Solemn Mass of Exposition**, which concludes with the **exposition of the Blessed Sacrament** and a **procession**. The Blessed Sacrament remains on the altar in a monstrance. During the next 40 hours, the faithful gather for personal or public prayer in adoration of our Lord.

Anytime the Blessed Sacrament is exposed in the Church or Chapel, children are welcome to participate in adoration, along with their parents. However, we have a special time each Tuesday from 4-5 pm for children and their parents to spend quality time with Our Lord. Parents may wish to consider the following:

**Reverence**-The beauty and truth of the Blessed Sacrament calls for adoration. Children should understand the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist;

**Gestures**- Help children learn how to genuflect, do the sign of the cross, use the rosary beads, etc.

**Prayer/ Intercession**- Pray for those in need through group prayer. Examples include: a decade of the Rosary, a Litany (Blessed Virgin Mary, Sacred Heart), the Divine Mercy Chaplet, etc.

**Proximity**- Children are allowed to draw close to the Sanctuary, pray on the floor near the altar, or sit in the front pew. However, please do not go up on the altar/steps

**Silence**- Children may read Bible stories, prayer books, look at images/stories about Saints, and use colored pencils to draw religious images, etc.










### PARISH OFFICE CLOSED
