



#### FROM OUR DEACON



Last Sunday completed a series of readings that are commonly known as the *Bread of Life Discourse*, in which Jesus tells us that we must eat His flesh and drink His blood if we are to have everlasting life. You and I eat Jesus' body and drink His blood every time we receive Communion during Mass. It is among the most important things we can do. I've recently had occasions at weddings and funerals in which the question who should/should not receive Communion at Mass was raised. Because the reception of Holy Communion is so sacred, it is important that we receive Him worthily. With that in mind, I thought it timely to relay the guidance provided by the Church on this critical matter. Simply put, there are three requirements for receiving Communion: being a Catholic, in the

state of grace, and observing a one-hour fast beforehand. To help people understand and to be clear, the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) compiled a listing of guidelines that would cover anyone who might happen to be at Mass. I hope the following information from the USCCB is helpful and instructive:

FOR CATHOLICS: As Catholics, we fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist when we receive Holy Communion. We are encouraged to receive Communion devoutly and frequently. In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, participants should not be conscious of grave sin and normally should have fasted for one hour. A person who is conscious of grave sin is not to receive the Body and Blood of the Lord without prior sacramental confession except for a grave reason where there is no opportunity for confession. In this case, the person is to be mindful of the obligation to make an act of perfect contrition, including the intention of confessing as soon as possible. Frequent reception of the Sacrament of Penance is encouraged for all.

FOR OUR FELLOW CHRISTIANS: We welcome our fellow Christians to this celebration of the Eucharist as our brothers and sisters. We pray that our common baptism and the action of the Holy Spirit in this Eucharist will draw us closer to one another and begin to dispel the sad divisions which separate us. We pray that these will lessen and finally disappear, in keeping with Christ's prayer for us "that they may all be one" (John 17:21). Because Catholics believe that the celebration of the Eucharist is a sign of the reality of the oneness of faith, life, and worship, members of those churches with whom we are not yet fully united are ordinarily not admitted to Holy Communion. Eucharistic sharing in exceptional circumstances by other Christians requires permission according to the directives of the diocesan bishop and the provisions of canon law. Members of the Orthodox Churches, the Assyrian Church of the East, and the Polish National Catholic Church are urged to respect the discipline of their own churches. According to Roman Catholic discipline, the Code of Canon Law does not object to the reception of Communion by Christians of these Churches.

**FOR THOSE NOT RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION:** All who are not receiving Holy Communion are encouraged to express in their hearts a prayerful desire for unity with the Lord Jesus and with one another.

FOR NON-CHRISTIANS: We also welcome to this celebration those who do not share our faith in Jesus Christ. While we cannot admit them to Holy Communion, we ask them to offer their prayers for the peace and the unity of the human family.

#### **WEEKLY REFLECTION**

### Happiness Is Within

We humans have a strange inclination to search for the wrong thing in the wrong place. We believe we'll be happy and satisfied if only we can acquire a new car, a new house, or more time for our hobbies. In spite of having experienced, time and again, that these things will not satisfy our hearts, we continually stir up new expectations that will do nothing but disappoint.

We think happiness is to be found outside ourselves, whereas it is really to be found inside ourselves, "The kingdom of God is among you," says Jesus (Lk 17:21). Things will not make us happy. On the contrary, they often prevent us from discovering the reign of God within us.

Become conscious of the fact that deep inside of you is found a temple of the Trinity, where the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit live and where you are immersed in love. You don't have to "seek" happiness. It is enough that you are conscious of the treasure you carry within you. The Christian faith teaches us that God lives within us, which is only a confirmation of what humankind has actually always known: Paradise lost exists within us. This we have forgotten. But we can again become conscious that it exists and where it exists. We can reclaim our riches when we are alone with God and stop seeking happiness outside ourselves.






