

FROM OUR PASTOR



In the Diocese of Arlington, **FORTY HOURS DEVOTION** has been widely celebrated following the establishment of the diocese in 1974, and has remained an important devotion in many parishes. At the heart of the Forty Hours of Devotion is the Holy Eucharist, the very Real and True Presence of God Himself. Most parishes in the diocese have hosted Forty Hours as part of the Diocesan wide preparation for our 50th Golden Jubilee this year. Our parish will once again offer this wonderful devotion beginning with Mass in the main church at 4:30 pm on August 22nd followed by a continuous period of solemn exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the chapel, concluding with benediction at 8:30 am on August 24th.



The number *forty* has always signified a sacred period of time: the rains during the time of Noah lasted 40 days and nights; the Jews wandered through the desert for 40 years; our Lord fasted and prayed for 40 days before beginning His public ministry. The 40 Hours Devotion remembers that traditional “forty-hour period” from our Lord’s burial until the resurrection.

The Forty Hours Devotion begins with a Solemn Mass of Exposition. The Blessed Sacrament remains on the altar in a monstrance during which the faithful gather for personal or public prayer in adoration of our Lord. Here the faithful implore our Lord to pour forth His abundant graces not only for themselves, but their neighbors; not only for their own personal needs, but for those of the world.

While the Forty Hours Devotion nurtures the love of the faithful for our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, three special dimensions have also surrounded this devotion:

- The protection from evil and temptation.
- Reparation for our own sins and for the Poor Souls in Purgatory.
- Deliverance from political, material, or spiritual calamities.

I strongly encourage all who are able to sign-up and participate in this wonderful opportunity to grow closer to our Lord, and offer much needed prayer for many in need. Please visit www.setonlakeridge.org/the-forty-hours-devotion

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Safe in Every Unrest

When Jesus dies on the cross, the “world” ends. The world of evil is annihilated. The sin of all the world – past, present, and to come – Jesus has taken upon himself. He has taken it into himself and atoned for it. To all appearances, the old world remains, but it has lost its power and is conquered once and for all. The sign that the old world has come to an end is the resurrection of Jesus. In his resurrection, the new, eternal world begins. All who believe – and thus participate in the resurrection – have already begun to live in this new world. The lordship and power of God has already been manifested in the death of Jesus on the cross. This is why the evangelists portray the death of Jesus in apocalyptic images: an eclipse of the sun, an earthquake, graves that are opened. It all makes us think of the last day. To you who live after Jesus and believe in him, the old world has ceased. You have seen through the deceit and vanity of the old world; it has no staying power, no substance. For this reason, you are not to trust it nor be afraid of it. Whatever happens to the world, it will never separate you from the love of Christ. You can be safe in every unrest, for the disturbances you encounter are only the spasms of an old world in the throes of death. The sufferings of all have been carried by Jesus to the Father. Therefore, you can no longer speak of the tragedy of life. Tragedy has been turned into a saving cross.



Anytime the Blessed Sacrament is exposed in the Church or Chapel, children are welcome to participate in adoration, along with their parents. In addition, we also have a special time designated each Tuesday from 4-5 pm for children and their parents to spend quality time with Our Lord. Parents may wish to consider the following:

Reverence-The beauty and truth of the Blessed Sacrament calls for adoration. Children should understand the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist;

Gestures- Help children learn how to genuflect, do the sign of the cross, use the rosary beads, etc.

Prayer/ Intercession- Pray for those in need through group prayer. Examples include: a decade of the Rosary, a Litany (Blessed Virgin Mary, Sacred Heart), the Divine Mercy Chaplet, etc.

Proximity- Children are allowed to draw close to the Sanctuary, pray on the floor near the altar, or sit in the front pew. However, please do not go up on the altar/steps

Silence- Children may read Bible stories, prayer books, look at images/stories about Saints, and use colored pencils to draw religious images, etc.




