





FROM OUR PAROCHIAL VICAR



Since I have been writing about the Holy Spirit in our lives, here is a passage by St. Anthony of Padua, who is a priest and doctor of the Church. He was a member of the Friars Minor and was the first member of the Franciscan Order to teach theology to his brothers in the Order. He died in Padua in 1231. (St. Francis of Assisi died in 1226). Here is an excerpt from one of St. Anthony's sermons.

"The man who is filled with the Holy Spirit speaks in different languages. These different languages are different ways of witnessing to Christ, such as humility, poverty, patience and obedience; we speak in those languages when we reveal in ourselves these virtues to others. Actions speak louder than words; let your words teach and your actions speak. We are full of words but empty of actions, and therefore, are cursed by the Lord, since he himself cursed the fig tree when he found no fruit on it but only leaves. St. Gregory the Great says: 'A law is laid upon the preacher to practice what he preaches.' It is useless for a man to flaunt his knowledge of the law if he undermines its teaching by his actions.

"But the apostles spoke '*as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim*' (Acts 2:4b). Happy the man whose words issue from the Holy Spirit and not from himself! For some men speak as their own character dictates, but steal the words of others and present them as their own and claim the credit for them. The Lord refers to such men and others like them in Jeremiah: '*Therefore, I am against the prophets – oracle of the Lord – those who steal my words from each other. Yes, I am against the prophets – oracle of the Lord – those who compose their own speeches and call them oracles. Yes, I am against the prophets who tell lying dreams – oracle of the Lord – those who lead my people astray by recounting their reckless lies. It was not I who sent them or commanded them; they do this people no good purpose at all – oracle of the Lord*' (Jeremiah 23:30-32).

"We should speak, then, as the Holy Spirit gives us the gift of speech. Our humble and sincere request to the Spirit for ourselves should be that we may bring the day of Pentecost to fulfillment, insofar as he infuses us with his grace, by using our bodily senses in a perfect manner and by keeping the commandments. Likewise, we shall request that we may be filled with a keen sense of sorrow and with fiery tongues for confessing the faith, so that our deserved reward may be to stand in the blazing splendor of the saints and to look upon the triune God."

WEEKLY REFLECTION

In the Footsteps of the Tax Collector

Jesus is always the one who takes the initiative when calling someone. "You did not choose me," he says, "But I chose you" (Jn 15:16). You don't have to do anything special to awaken his love and attract his attention. Before you knew how to long for love, he has loved you. "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you" (Jer 1:5).

But your answer to his call is the only thing that can complete God's act of creation, and it is important *immediately* to answer with an unconditional and wholehearted "yes" when you hear the call.

When Matthew, the tax collector, is called, he leaves everything old with a total readiness to follow Jesus (9:9). He doesn't ask to finish what he was doing, or to "think it over" before committing himself. He says "yes" without really knowing what he's getting into. Jesus has not shown him his intentions. The significant thing is that Jesus calls *now*, and that Matthew answers *now*.

Your life becomes infinitely simpler when you say "yes" to God spontaneously, without nervously speculating about the possible implications. Heavy burdens are lifted if only you live from moment to moment, and in each moment say "yes" to God. Jesus calls you not only once in life; he calls you anew, again and again.

Director of Disciple Formation



In addition, to anytime the Blessed Sacrament is exposed in the Church or Chapel, we also have a special time designated each Tuesday from 4-5 pm for children and their parents to spend quality time with Our Lord. Parents may wish to consider the following:

Reverence-The beauty and truth of the Blessed Sacrament calls for adoration. Children should understand the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist;

Gestures- Help children learn how to genuflect, do the sign of the cross, use the rosary beads, etc.

Prayer/Intercession- Pray for those in need through group prayer. Examples include: a decade of the Rosary, a Litany (Blessed Virgin Mary, Sacred Heart), the Divine Mercy Chaplet, etc.

Proximity- Children are allowed to draw close to the Sanctuary, pray on the floor near the altar, or sit in the front pew. However, please do not go up on the altar/steps

Silence- Children may read Bible stories, prayer books, look at images/stories about Saints, and use colored pencils to draw religious images, etc.


