PLEASE SAVE THE DATE of **Wednesday, September 11th** for the long-anticipated **PRINCE WILLIAM COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING: AT 7 PM** in the **McCoart Building located in the Prince William County Complex.** (1 County Complex Ct, Woodbridge, VA 22192).



PRINCE WILLIAM COUNTY

This very important Public Hearing will consider approval of our parish's Special Use Permit (SUP) application to continue construction for our Capital Campaign Projects, including the columbarium. Please show your support by your silent presence as we seek to have as many enthusiastic Seton Lake Ridge Parishioners there as possible.



This first of two public hearings (County Supervisor's vote later on final consideration) will be to review our remaining **Phase III -V Facilities Master Plan.** These phases involve several differed maintenance issues including badly needed new pavement, inadequate exterior lighting, erosion, and installation of a drainage system for the underground spring that unfortunately surfaces in the middle of our parking lot. It will also allow for improvements to the parish campus including a connector plaza, parish outreach center, columbarium, walking path and more. Caring for and improving our facilities ensures the

ministerial life of our parish and that the sacramental and spiritual lives of every member of our parish family will function at a higher level.

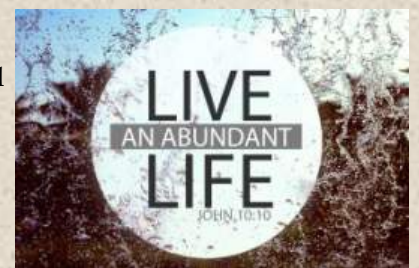
WEEKLY REFLECTION

Everything in Abundance

When Jesus sends the disciples out to feed the crowds, all they have are two small fish and five loaves of bread. They do not know what will happen. They have no great quantity to distribute. It is in the passing out that the bread and the fish multiply.

The gifts of God exist to be handed on. As long as you pass them out, you have more to give. If you are afraid to give what you have, you shouldn't be surprised to find yourself empty inside as well. The disciples give without reserve, and for that reason they always have more to give. If all of humankind had been gathered on that mountain to listen to Jesus, everyone would have been nourished by the five loaves and two fish.

When everyone has been fed, there is more left than there was at the start. Each disciple had less than half a loaf to distribute. Afterward, they each have their own basket full of leftovers. God gives everything in abundance. God's grace is not measured strictly according to our needs. God gives much more than is needed. He knows that we inevitably will waste some of what he has given. He takes this into consideration from the very beginning, and therefore he gives "a good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over" (Lk 6:38). If we open ourselves to all God gives and pass it out, we will always have his grace in abundance.

MEMORIAL MASS FOR FATHER CAPODANNO

Wednesday, Sept. 4 | 6:30pm
Crypt Church of the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception

The Memorial Mass for Father Vincent R. Capodanno, MM, will take place in the Crypt Church of the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. His Excellency, the Most Reverend Timothy P. Broglio, J.C.D., Archbishop for the Military Services, USA, will be the principal celebrant. This annual Mass is celebrated in memory of Father Capodanno, killed in Vietnam on September 4, 1967, as he ministered to embattled Marines. Father Capodanno posthumously received the Medal of Honor, and in May 2006 the Catholic Church officially proclaimed him a Servant of God and thus formally initiated his Cause for Canonization. The Father Vincent Capodanno Guild is the only official organization established to promote the cause for canonization of Father Capodanno.

RETREAT FOR THE SERIOUSLY ILL

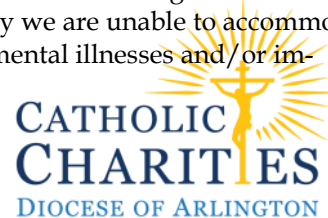
Friday – Sunday, September 27-29 | San Damiano Retreat Center, White Post, VA | No Cost to Participate

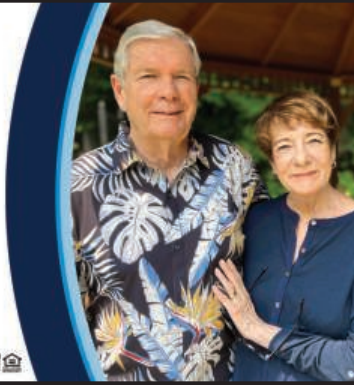
