# WEEKLY REFLECTION

# Knowing God in the Midst of Life

The Bible gives us a synthesis of the whole of reality, but it contains no developed systematic theology or anthropology. What is primary in the Bible is actual experiences.

If you put theoretical questions to the Bible, it will give you concrete answers. You ask: Who is God? The Bible answers: Live as a child of your heavenly Father, dare to be a child, confident and free of worry, follow Jesus who is the beloved Son of the Father. You ask: What is prayer? The answer is encouraging: Pray "Our father who art in heaven...." What is love? You have no time to philosophize about love: Do as the good Samaritan does, feed the hungry, visit the sick. To know God is not to philosophically speculate about him. The one who lives according to



God's commandments gets to know him. "Now by this we may be sure that we know him, if we obey his commandments. Whoever says, 'I have come to know him,' but does not obey his commandments, is a liar, and in such a person the truth does not exist" (1 Jn 2:3-4).

Theology is important and leads us on the path to truth. But truth itself can never be contained in theoretical statements and concepts. It is the attitude of your will and your heart that will give you the real information about God.







# SETON LAKE RIDGE VCC ADVOCACY

Pope Francis exhorts us to "genuine dialogue and openness to others," by which we may "be frank and open about our beliefs, while continuing to discuss, to seek points of contact, and above all, to work and struggle together" (Fratelli Tutti, no. 203). This applies to the faithful both as voters and as candidates – we must consider not only candidates' positions on these issues, but their character and integrity as well.

How can we meet the challenge of genuine dialogue and openness to others? St. Paul gives us a way: Put on "the mind of Christ" (1 Cor. 2:16). Take time away from social media and spend time with Holy Scripture and the Blessed Sacrament. Turn off the TV and the podcast, and listen in silence. Volunteer at a soup kitchen, a homeless shelter, a crisis pregnancy center. Serve the poor, the needy, and the outcast. Pray often, letting faith inform your political participation.
