



The Human Concerns Ministry at Seton Lake Ridge is dedicated to supporting (through service) the needs of the poor, the homeless, the hungry, the elderly, the ill and disabled in our parish, diocese, and community. This ministry provides opportunities to parishioners of all ages to perform the corporal works of mercy, through its myriad outreach programs.

Aside from our Outreach Programs, the Human Concerns Ministry also oversees the parish's Respect Life Ministry and our parish's affiliation with and support of the work of the VCC (Virginia Catholic Conference).

The ministry overseas the year-round operation of the Mother Seton Food Pantry, and recently sponsored the Christmas Giving Tag Tree Program which provided 1,068 gifts for the residents of St. Margaret of Cortona and Christ House, two Diocesan transitional housing programs for the homeless, as well as the homeless men and women who access the Evening Meal Program at Christ House. BUILDING AND MASTER PLAN UPDATES

We are so excited that **Phase III of our Five Phase Facilities Master Plan** is one step closer to becoming a Reality! As we continue to move forward in this process, our next steps are to begin preparing **construction documents**, along with other materials, so we may begin taking orders and securing the **sale of columbarium niches** in the <u>first half of 2025</u>! [Please visit our parish website https://setonlakeridge.org/capital-campaign-2021 for more details.] We are also exploring the possibility of opening a Pre-K program in the fall of 2025. This program would utilize our existing nursery space as a satellite campus of St. Thomas Aquinas Regional School, our shared parish school located on the grounds of Our Lady of Angels Parish near Route 1. More information will be forthcoming in early January 2025.



Once the construction documents are finalized, we will obtain cost estimates to develop the financial model needed to complete Phase III, and following this, we will seek final approval from the Bishop and his Building Commission in the latter half of 2025. The final step will be securing approval of our overall completed site-plan from the county, a process estimated to take 9–12 months from the time of submission. Our Civil Engineers hope to have the site plan submitted by early Spring 2025 which means that the earliest construction *could* begin would be in spring or early summer of 2026. The duration of construction could last 18-24 months, so the <u>estimate of time of completion would be</u> late 2027.

I want to thank Almighty God and you, the good people of Seton Lake Ridge for your generous financial contributions, support and prayers. Stay tuned for more updates in the new year
