




the Fellowship Hall); and welcome to our new <u>Tuesday and Thursday Office Receptionist</u>, <u>TRACY GRUBBS</u> who will be joining us on July 19th.

As part of some exciting new initiatives regarding our **FAMILY FAITH FORMATION PROGRAM**, on July 5th we welcomed **DORI COOK** our new **Coordinator of Sacrament Preparation**, who will be working along-side our own **MYLENE GARCIA** who was promoted to **Coordinator of Family Faith Formation**. Both Dori and Mylene will be working under the direction of **KRIS FISCHER** who will take on a broader role as our new **Director of Disciple Formation**. Kris will be working as a team with **KARA LILLY** who will also take on broader responsibilities in the parish as our new **Coordinator of Disciple Accompaniment** (*More on Kris and Kara's new responsibilities in a future pastor's column*).

To better support the religious formation of our children and youth, and to more intentionally collaborate with parents in those efforts, we are going to incorporate into our program the following new changes and initiatives beginning this fall:

- Our two sessions will be <u>moved to Sunday morning</u>, Session I: 8:45-10:15am; and Session II: 10:30am-12:00pm
- K-5th Grade <u>parents are going to be a more integral part of our program</u> and join their children in "class", which will now be referred to as "<u>Small Groups</u>". 6th -12th Grade parents will also meet at the time of their youth's session in another format. This way families will be better able to <u>attend Sunday Mass together</u> and grow <u>in their faith</u> formation journey as a family in collaboration with their larger parish family.



- For Grades 1-8, we will be generally be using MY CATHOLIC FAITH DELIVERED (*Ignatius Press, Faith & Life Series*) for families to engage the material at home on-line prior to a discussion of the lesson that will take place during each Small Group Session. Kindergarten and 9th-12th will utilize other materials/formats.
- "Catechists" will now be referred to as "Small Group Facilitators" and have the option to advance with their Small Group each year as they progress through the program.

Registration is forthcoming later this month and more details will soon be posted on our parish web-site and in our bulletin.

WEEKLY REFLECTION

God's Invisibility

When Jesus promises the disciples that he will return (Jn 14:18), he is not only referring to the brief moments they meet after the Resurrection. He returns in a more permanent way, in time and history, through the Eucharist. The Eucharist is something incomprehensibly mysterious. You get to eat and drink the body and blood of Christ. He is palpably and concretely present. At the same time, nothing is so unfathomable as this concrete presence. God reveals himself in the Eucharist, but it is his hiddenness he reveals. You may, at times, envy the disciples who



lived with Jesus and saw his face. But you can get to know him better than they did, when you meet him hidden. When the disciples saw Jesus, they imagined themselves seeing all that he was, that there were no more secrets about him. But Jesus is much more than they were able to see. He is the Father's eternal Word, he is a great mystery. In the Eucharist, God's incomprehensibility is shown. You can see God, but what you see is his invisibility. In the Eucharist everything is so simple, so ordinary, that a child can understand it. But precisely because it is so simple we don't get stuck on the external but are, rather, led deeper into the incomprehensibility of God. God appears to have a fondness for turning our common perceptions upside-down. What is small, he makes big and what is big he makes small. Through small, limited means, bread and wine, God shows his endless greatness.

This Month's Devotion: The Litany of the Precious Blood



The Litany of the Most Precious Blood pays tribute to the blood our Lord both shed for us in His Passion and offers us in

the Eucharist for our salvation.

It is important to remember that the host we consume at Mass is indeed the body, blood, soul and divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ! (Although the wine at communion is "my blood of the new covenant" as our Lord put it at the Last Supper (Mark 14:24) the host as the body of Christ contains our Lord's blood as well.)

The Litany of the Most Precious Blood was approved for public use in 1960 by Pope John XXIII, although devotion to the Precious Blood goes back centuries. Indeed, as Father Faber wrote in 1860 "the lives of the saints are replete with devotion to the precious blood." The month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood in the Church's Liturgical Calendar.


