

Dear Parishioners of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Church

On behalf of Medical Missionaries, a Manassas-based-all-volunteer 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization, we thank you for your check, in the amount of \$11,173.39, representing your very generous contributions to your parish's 2023 Lenten Giving Tree Program. We are honored that our St. Joseph Clinic (Hospital) in Thomassique, Haiti was chosen as this year's recipient.

The Funds will allow us to continue our support of the poorest of the poor via the Clinic's myriad programs which serve Thomassique and its outlying villages, a population estimated to total 125,000 or more. The Clinic is a comprehensive medical facility, open 5 days a week for general consults and medical care, and 24/7 for emergency and maternity care. It has overnight accommodations for up to 20 patients.

Your monetary gift helps support our Medika Mamba program which feeds the many starving, underweight, malnourished, failure to thrive or near death babies. Through this intervention babes now survive their infancy with non lost to death. Prior to St. joseph Clinic, babies who would not have survived now flourish. Many mothers and babies would not survive if not for our Mother and nfanct Care Program, particularly those in need of home births. Our Midwife-trained Matwons not only deliver at home using Clean Delivery Kits but also refer at-risk mothers to St. Joseph Clinic or transport them to Hospital in Hinche.

We thank you again for caring. May God bless you and your families for making the sacrifice to provide a better life for the poor.




