Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our diocesan priests dedicated their lives to serving and guiding us on our life-long journey of faith, and many continue to offer their priestly ministry in retirement. They renewed us in the grace of Christ by celebrating the sacraments, preaching the Gospel, offering encouragement through life's crosses, and praying for us and our families. They continue to pray for us and serve the diocese and God's people in their retirement years.

Currently there are 176 diocesan priests serving the Diocese of Arlington. Of these, 29 priests are retired, and over the next ten years, 22 additional priests will reach retirement age. At all Masses on *May 17-18*, the annual second collection for retired priests will take place in parishes.

The funds from this annual collection address several specific needs, including the ongoing operational expenses of the *Saint Rose of Lima Priests' Retirement Villa*, a residence for up to 15 priests. This special collection will also provide funds for clergy post-retirement health care, nursing home care, and the priests' pension fund.

I ask you to be as generous as possible so that our priests, who have faithfully served the People of God in the diocese, may be cared for in their retirement years.

May Our Lord Jesus bless you with his peace and increased faith, hope, and love throughout the Jubilee Year and always.

Saturday, June 14 | 9:30am (After 9AM Mass) | Main Church

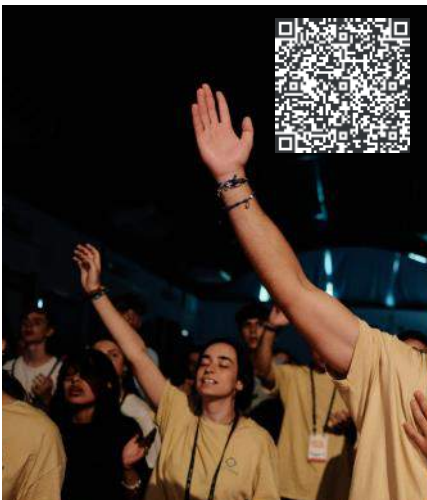
The Legion of Mary is sponsoring a parish-wide Home Enthronement of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and your family is invited!

UNLOCKING THE SECRET OF GOD'S PARTICULAR CALL

From the Diocese of Arlington

Have you felt that God could be calling you to be a priest or brother? No matter what your vocation, the process of discovering it is half of the battle. Done right, this process lays a firm foundation for your living out of this vocation, be it to marriage, dedicated single life, or priesthood and religious life.

Here are *some* (full list and more available on arlingtondiocese.org/vocations/for-men/ or arlingtondiocese.org/vocations/for-men/how-to-become-a-priest/) practical suggestions which are a good basis for a diligent discernment. Doing these things will not turn you into a priest or religious, but they are keys which move you toward the goal of becoming holy and more open to the grace of God at work in your life:

- **Daily Mass:** If you are not going every day or cannot go every day, then start small. Just go one more time than you are already going to Mass each week, and then as you get used to that add another until you find yourself frequenting daily Mass.
- **Daily Rosary:** If you are not currently in the habit of praying a rosary each day, just start with one decade and build up the habit from there.
- **Frequent Confession:** The Sacrament of Penance is considered the sacrament of discernment, because every time you go to confession you have to compare who you are with the person God is calling you to be. If you are seriously discerning a vocation to the priesthood or religious life, it is recommended you go to confession every 2-3 weeks, or at the very least once a month.

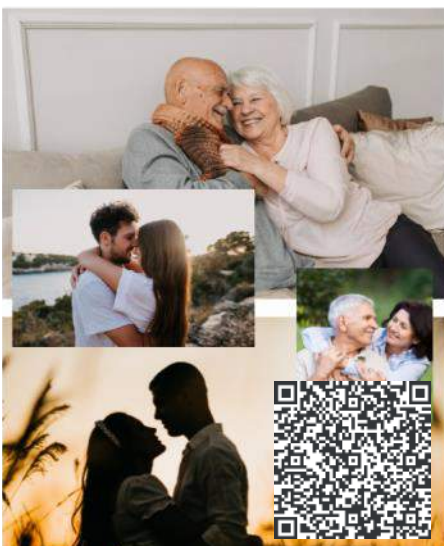

FROM YOUR BUSINESS MANAGER #10

Dear Parishioners: I hope you've all been enjoying the Easter season! First up in this edition is the Fiscal Year 2026 budget. Fiscal Years in the Diocese of Arlington run from July thru June, so with just a couple of months left in this fiscal year, we're right in the peak of budget preparation season. The final draft of the budget will be presented to the Finance Council for approval in June. The Parish will receive a summary of the budget with the Annual Financial Report to parishioners this Fall (contact me if you have any budget-related questions). A related issue is collection numbers which continue to exceed last year's numbers by a respectable margin! This is great news for our Parish, our Pastor and the Diocese (and for me - less gray hair!). I see the sustained increase as a reflection of the great faith our Parish has in Our Lord Jesus Christ and His Church. Speaking of collections, let's talk a bit about the Annual Parish Special Needs Second Collection, which takes place on Mother's Day Weekend, May 10th and 11th. All contributions to this collection remain 'in house' and will be used to pay for a sorely needed outdoor sound system which will support Parish Events like the Spring Block Party, Fall Festival, Eucharistic Processions, Music on the Lawn, Vacation Bible School and more. I ask you to consider giving generously to the Parish Special Needs Collection so we can pay for our wonderful new sound system!

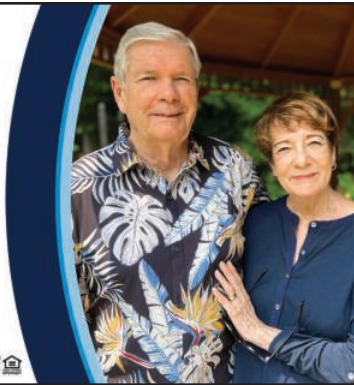
